



Travel Tips

General

Please check with your carrier regarding TSA regulations!

1. Be sure your luggage is marked with identification on the inside and out. Put inside your luggage your destination (Scuola Italia's Address) with your name printed clearly.
2. Make at least two lists of your credit card numbers and travelers check serial numbers and put them in 2 different locations. **NOT IN YOUR LUGGAGE.**
3. Call your bank and credit card companies to alert them that you will be traveling out of the US to Europe. Also make sure your pin # will work in the countries you are planning to travel. In this way they will not stop your transactions.
4. Bring photocopies of your passport and other travel papers as well as a few passport -sized pictures, in case your documents are lost or stolen.
5. If you plan to drive, get your car ready and investigate the local road conditions, laws and other driving requirements. An International Driver's License may be required.
6. Remember an address book if you plan to send postcards
7. Do some research to learn as much as you can about your destination.
8. When traveling to Europe bring about € (euro's) 200 so that you don't have to wait in line at the foreign exchange the moment you arrive. Also rates might be high at airports.

Health

1. Carry your prescription medication in their original containers. This may make it easier to get them through customs. Check prescriptions for necessary refills; bring a list of all generic drugs name listed since the brand names may be available by may vary by region. Bring a 2 Month Supply of all prescription medications.
2. Bring your doctor's name, regular and emergency phone numbers.
3. Check your own medical insurance coverage to see what type of coverage you may have when you are away. Consider purchasing Health & Travel Insurance through our link provided on the website.
4. Find out what types of vaccinations you will need to enter the country, there may also be medications you will need to take before, during and even after your trip. Get your vaccinations done early in case you have a reaction and need some recovery time.
5. Bring extra eyeglasses or contacts if you have them.

Safety
